Respond in FRENCH to each situation.

#### **Question 1** (3 marks)

# Question 2 (3 marks)

You stop a passer-by in the street.

- Ask how to get to the Picasso Museum in Grandin Street.
- Spell the name of the street G-R-A-N-D-I-N.
- Repeat the directions you are given.
- Ask if it is far.

### **Question 3** (4 marks)

You have lost something and you go to the police station.

- Tell the person what you have lost.
- Give a brief description of the item.
- Say why you are worried.
- Ask what you should do.

#### **Question 4** (5 marks)

You are an exchange student at a French school. You make an enquiry at the office.

- Ask if you can leave school early.
- Ask the person to repeat the answer because you do not understand.
- Explain why you need to leave early.
- Thank the person for his/her help.

# Question 5 (5 marks)

You phone a friend.

- Ask him/her what he/she will do during the holidays.
- Tell him/her your own plans.
- Mention what you did last year.
- Explain why you will not do the same thing again.
