A od onih koji nastave studij nakon odgo?ene godine, više od trećine ih promijeni studij nakon povratka na fakultete\, kazao je Chalke.

## **Section 1, Part A**

### **Text 1**

Nedavno je Catriona Rowntree sa poznatog australskog programa Getaway posjetila stari grad Dubrovnik. Bila je oduševljena ljepotom ovog povjesnog grada koji je ujedno i vrlo moderan u svojim ponudama koncerata, kazališnih predstava, raznovrsnih restorana a i prekrasnih dućana nakita i starina. Dubrovnik je samo jedan od mnogih prekrasnih gradova uzduž Jadranske obale, a to svake godine otkriva sve veći broj turista. Krajem kolovoza ostvareno je oko 80 posto ovogodišnjeg turističkog prometa. Od početka godine na hrvatskom Jadranu odmaralo se 7.3 milijuna turista, a to je rast od 4%. Iduće godine ministarstvo očekuje porast od 8%.

### **Text 2**

- A: Na Europskom prvenstvu u kriketu C kategorije hrvatski kriketaši osvojili su prvo mjesto. Razgovaramo s Jasenom Butkovićem, jednim od reprezentativaca i jednim od osnivača kriket kluba Zagreb. Kako je došlo do osnivanja kriketskog kluba?

- B: Kriket je nacionalni sport u Australiji. Mi smo naučili igrati u školi, ali nikad nismo igrali ozbiljno. Sada redovito vježbamo i počeli su nam dolaziti i domaći ljudi. Članova imamo sve više i nakon osnivanja kriketskog saveza očekujem još veći interes. Već smo počeli trenirati za iduće Europsko prvenstvo.
- A: I tako ste započeli novu sportsku tradiciju u Hrvatskoj?
- B: Jesmo i nismo. Uskoro nakon osnutka kriket kluba Zagreb niknuo je još jedan klub na otoku Visu. Osnovao ga je Tomislav Belobrajdić, također povratnik iz Australije. Ali zanimljivo je da je otok Vis jedino mjesto u Hrvatskoj koje ima kriketsku tradiciju. Pred dvjesto godina, za vrijeme Napoleonskih ratova, na Visu su bili stacionirani Englezi i oni su tamo imali svoje terene i klubove. Sada se očekuje da će kriketski klub na Visu biti ujedno i turistička atrakcija.
