

2010 HSC Modern Greek Beginners Sample Answers

This document contains 'sample answers', or, in the case of some questions, 'answers could include'. These are developed by the examination committee for two purposes. The committee does this:

- (a) as part of the development of the examination paper to ensure the questions will effectively assess students' knowledge and skills, and
- (b) in order to provide some advice to the Supervisor of Marking about the nature and scope of the responses expected of students.

The 'sample answers' or similar advice are not intended to be exemplary or even complete answers or responses. As they are part of the examination committee's 'working document', they may contain typographical errors, omissions, or only some of the possible correct answers.

Question 16 (c)

Sample answer:

Question 17 (a)

Sample answer:

Question 17 (c)

Sample answer:

Liana is frustrated her parents never consider her feelings. She is determined to stay this time and this is revealed through the use of exclamations such as "Apketá $\pi \iota \dot{\alpha}$ " The use of emotive language such as "Koupáστηκα $\pi \iota \alpha$...", and rhetorical questions such as "Kaipós δεν είναι να σκεφτώ τον εαυτό μου;" reveal that she has made a decision to take a stand. The use of repetition, eg καινούρια, καινούριους, reinforce her feelings of frustration.
