Playunight Danio Fo is a master at using "Farce as a political weapon", which has become a diche for describing the successful unpredictable and botally extraordinany playunight. In Fos two plays, Accidental Death of An Anarchist, and Car't Pay? Won't Pay!, the use of satine, audience, force, tersion, characterisation commedia del onte and juxtoposition, all prove that Fos satisfical style is very adminable and definitely aids his revolutionary comments on society, rather than distracting "us from his servious political intent. Fo uses his humanous conventions and "comic performance styles" to evoke thought in his audiences, and express his idealogies and wiews on the injustices in Italy, and the would en general.



In Accidental Death of An Anarchist, Fo has used characterisation with his "epic closur" genno to create the Mariac, who creates chaos in the play. The Mariae reflects Fos jester character which he often uses in his plays to reveal the stupicity of authoritive figures, as evident in his scene where the maniac confuses The inspector who believes the maniae is "sane", but the marriac explairs that he is "centified mad. There are many moments of chaos where the mariae makes the inspector to look stupid in adking in a saturical style to see your school reports" to check that his "granna" was correct. Danio to successfully creates a humanous link between his plays and real wife situations, which as to hinself descrobes that in macking authority in his plays in a humorous way creates



respect from the audience, as he describes himself, "There is no greater equalism than The stupicity of men-especially when These men have power, which explains his serious intertion revealed in his plays. The use of slapstick and commedia del arte is a performance style in which To has successfully used in Accidental Death Of An Aranchist and Can't Pay? Won't Pay, to show real issues of police raids, pinellis deathy price rises. Fo dees not want to create a colhaisis with his audiences, he wants them to be aware of the injustices wither the world, in which he uses humour, because he states that "laughter opers people's meids and renders then reseptive to ideas they meight otherwise reject. In one particular siere the Mariac ain falls off, and he states in a mocking lone that next you'll be pulling



off my leg," this incident symbolises the hidden mishappenings in The sowely, Things which are covered up such as pixellis death and other in wdents, the audience laught yet reognises and asknowledges Fo's purpose for this ymbolic ann and they helate and act on the services issues of injustices and hidden incidents by politicians, police and other organisations. In Cant Pay? Work Pay!, Slapstick is a convertion which to has used to show stupidity and create relief forman entense moment. The chaos bigins when Marghenitta explains that shes "pregnant with phopping" to the audience and as The chae's occurs, "she's dripping" says The inspector who pretends to know everything, and says that "it means she's near her time, however the dripping is a burst bag of slives which creates



mayhem and confusion in the play, speaking to the audience on a deeper level on the "stupidity of men" and hidden events within Italian sowitige To does not want his audiences to have an emotional break down, rather to asknowledge and act on his ideologies about the injustices of price rise, munder and the statement that "Fos use of comic performance styles distracts is for this serious political entent is enaceurate, as a real to tyle performance proves meaning and value beyond wonds.

In Accidental death of An Anarchist and Can't Pay? Won't Pay! To breaks the 4th wave with the andvence, as he intoracts, and creates an atmosphere where the audience is aware of each element in the play, and creating the sense of being co compinatons with the



characters in the play to the marriar changes from a "consel of the high cont", to a representative for "forersics", The audience laugho and admires the 3 arey approach to convey the stupid side of many members in high places, who rould be just as qualified as the marriac. Fo expresses how politicions one fake in there "promises of reform", and the audience feels involved in the final song of Anarchy, in which the voice and opinions of these people are heard through the marval. Playunight Danio Fo is successful er conveying his, political concerns and ideologies to his international andiences. To heriself argues that by his use of the down its the voice of oppressed Italian people, and humour opens peoples mends. To is very successful



in his plays Accidental death of An-Anorchist and Can't Pay?
