Conceptual understanding that draws links to pertinent issues of disadvantage needed to be addressed specifically to enhance the explanation of the role of legal and non-legal agents. Examples were relevant, with salient detail provided consistently across the task, demonstrating sound research and analysis in the process of selecting and integrating information.
