

Automotive Curriculum Framework

Coding and numbering system for units of competency

The following information is drawn from the *Automotive Industry Retail, Service and Repair Training Package (AUR05)*.¹

Each unit of competency in AUR05 has a unique code. These codes have a consistent format and identify a range of information.

For example:

AURC270103A Apply safe working practices

- first three letters (eg AUR) – identifies the Training Package
- fourth letter (eg C) – identifies the competency field
 - C = common
- first number (eg 2) – indicates the relevant AQF level
- remaining numbers (eg 7.1.3) – indicate the unit number within the Training Package
- last letter (eg A) – indicates the version of the unit.

There are units of competency from a range of different competency fields of the Automotive Industry Retail, Service and Repair Training Package (AUR05) included in the Automotive Curriculum Framework (2007).

The following codes are for the competency fields included in the Framework:

Code	Field	Code	Field
A	Administration	R	Recreational Boating
B	Bicycles	S	Sales
C	Common	T	Technical
E	Electrical	V	Vehicle Body
P	Outdoor Power Equipment
