

# Hospitality Curriculum Framework

## Coding and numbering system for units of competency

The following information is drawn from the *Tourism, Hospitality and Events Training Package (SIT07)*.<sup>1</sup>

Each unit of competency in SIT07 has a unique code. These codes have a consistent format and identify a range of information.

For example:

SITHIND001A Develop and update hospitality industry knowledge

- first two letters (eg SI) – identifies the industry skills council
  - SI = Service Skills Australia
- third letter (eg T) – identifies the Training Package
  - T = Tourism, Hospitality and Events
- fourth letter (eg H) – identifies the sector
  - H = hospitality
- next three letters (eg IND) – identifies the competency field/functional area
  - IND = working in industry
- three numbers (eg 001) – indicate the consecutive number in the field
- last letter (eg A) – indicates the version of the unit.

There are units of competency from two sectors of the Tourism, Hospitality and Events Framework (SIT07) included in the Hospitality Curriculum Framework (2008). The codes for these two sectors are:

- H – hospitality
- X – cross-sector.

There are units of competency from a range of different functional areas/fields of the Tourism, Hospitality and Events Training Package (SIT07) included in the Hospitality Curriculum Framework (2008).

The following codes are for the functional areas/fields included in the Framework:
