

**Revised Rotation of Course Prescriptions  
Latin Continuers and Extension courses**

From 2006 each prose text and from 2007 each verse text in Latin Continuers will be prescribed for three consecutive years. From 2008 each text in Latin Extension will be prescribed for three consecutive years. The rotation of texts for both courses from 2006 – 2010, with each new text shown in bold, is as follows:
