

## 2 Course Delivery

### 2.1 General Information

Teaching programs for courses in the Primary Industries Curriculum Framework can be developed using a number of different approaches. These include:

- programming individual units of competency sequentially
- identifying a theme which is common to several units of competency and programming teaching and learning activities which address this theme
- devising a project, experience or event which requires students to learn and use a number of competencies
- a combination of any of the above.

Each approach has merit depending on the nature of particular competencies selected, access to facilities, equipment, resources and work places, and the needs and experiences of students.

When considering these approaches, teachers and trainers should keep in mind the following general principles:

- VET courses focus on the achievement of workplace competence. They are intended to equip students with the skills and knowledge required to perform workplace roles to the standard expected in industry. Competence incorporates all aspects of work performance including communication, problem solving and the capacity to apply skills and knowledge in both familiar and new situations as well as industry specific skills.
- Students must be given the opportunity to develop skills over time and have multiple opportunities to demonstrate that they possess the necessary combination of skills and knowledge.
- Students must have the opportunity to develop and practise skills in a workplace setting.
- Assessment of competence involves the assessment of skills and knowledge combined. An **integrated** or **holistic** approach to assessment is encouraged in line with the concept of competence as the integration of a wide range of skills, knowledge and attitudes. An integrated approach to course delivery will facilitate integrated competency assessment.

On the basis of these principles, it is recommended that teachers and trainers develop teaching and learning programs which allow for the integrated development of several elements and/or units of competency simultaneously. Where this is not possible, learning activities developed for individual units of competency should seek to integrate elements within the unit and to address the linkages to other units identified in the training package and in the syllabus.

In particular, students should be given frequent opportunities to develop and update industry knowledge for primary industries and to consolidate skills and knowledge with respect to the environment, safety and teamwork.

Where possible, assessment tasks and events should be included as an integral part of training.

## 2.2 Sequence of Delivery

Neither the Primary Industries Curriculum Framework nor the Training Packages prescribes a particular delivery sequence for individual units of competency or for related groups of units of competency. Refer to the *Primary Industries Curriculum Framework Part A* for information on course structures.

The sequencing of a teaching program for a particular course is a matter for the teacher's professional judgement, based on the existing skills and experience of students, student interest, access to facilities including workplaces and the timing of work placement.

### 2.2.1 Relationships between units of competency

Relationships exist between units of competency and this should inform programming and assessment activities.

Units of competency generally need to be linked to reflect the skills required for a job role.

While holistic assessment is recommended, most units of competency in the Training Packages can be assessed independently. There are also some units that **must** be assessed prior to other units (pre-requisites). This is the case when the skills and knowledge essential to the achievement of a particular unit of competency are found in other units. The information below has been reproduced directly from the Training Packages.

The linkages\* identified only relate to the units of competency included in the Primary Industries Curriculum Framework.

## 2.2.2 Category status of units of competency for qualifications available in the Primary Industries Curriculum Framework

The qualification packaging rules for the AQF qualifications available in this framework through the 120 and 240 indicative hour courses are outlined in section 15 in Part A of the syllabus. This information is reproduced from the Conservation and Land Management Training Package (RTD02), Amenity Horticulture Training Package (RTF03) and the Rural Production Training Package (RTE03).

The qualification packaging rules for the AQF qualifications available in this framework through the Specialisation Studies and Extension are available in the relevant Training Package or at [www.ntis.com.au](http://www.ntis.com.au).

Students who meet these requirements will be eligible for the relevant AQF Certificate, whether or not they have met the additional requirements of the HSC course.

Units of competency within the Conservation and Land Management, Amenity Horticulture and Rural Production qualifications for Certificate I through to Advanced Diploma have been packaged together to form a meaningful work-related focus for key industry sectors or areas of specialisation.

The mechanism for accommodating each sector or area of specialisation qualification has been achieved by developing three lists of competency standards in each stream:

- Group A – these are the key technical work functions that have been designated for each sector specialisation. Standards that are compulsory for each qualification are shown in italics in the packaging rules for this group.
- Group B – these are the more generic work functions across a number of industry sectors.
- Group C – these include units competency from the Training Package not listed in Group A or B at that level, and relevant standards from other rural Training Packages and other nationally endorsed Training Packages.

The following tables indicate the category status of each unit of competency available in the framework. This information, along with Table 8 in Part A of the syllabus, will assist teachers when selecting elective units of competency to meet qualification packaging rules.

When selecting units of competency, the Training Packages state:

- units should be selected from Group A and B in accordance with local work undertaken and local industry advice (some Group A units are compulsory)
- 80% of units of competency must relate to the procedures, activities or contexts for that qualification
  - eg for Certificate II in Agriculture *specialising in* Sheep and Wool Production at least 13 of the units of competency presented must relate to sheep and wool production work procedures, activities or contexts
- 80% of units of competency for qualifications must be clearly aligned to the AQF Certificate level outcomes
  - eg for Certificate III in Horticulture at least 12 of the units selected must be clearly aligned to Certificate III outcomes.

Advice regarding the category status of units of competency in Primary Industries (120 and 240 indicative hour courses) for the qualifications in Table 1 is contained in Table 8, section 15, Part A of the syllabus.
