Most Aboriginal Australians are either unemployed or on government pay e.g. Youth allowance, the Dink, or some form of government pay.

The aboriginal people who work are either under paid ~~and~~ and usually earning ~~at~~ less than ~~the~~ ^{the} average Australian.

Most employment companies do not give most Aboriginal people equal rights making it unfair for them to work.








