Spiritually, being handed back is
very Important because the mountain
has songlines which connect to
other mountains such as Mumbulla.
The songlines are an Important
Spiritualness to the Yun people of
NSW. The songlines interconnect
with other groups all over Awtrewic
and they are able to contact
them Spiritually. The songlines
are Significant to their dreaming.

It is also very significant being handed ball Gulage mointein because Indigonous people now look after it themselves.
