a) Australiar Aboriginal people within society today are at alarming & face many alarming health problems and are at great risk of serious health issues, such as Cancer. Although improved, Aboriginal individuals are still being impacted on by such health issues as Diabetes 1 and 2, infections, HIV and STI diseases, chronic heart problems and a poor diet resulting in weight gain and iminimal physical activity. The Indigenous peoples of Australia face a low # life expectancy rate with Aboriginal Females dying around the age of 71 and Aboriginal males at a young 67. This highlights the poor health of Australia's indigenous people as there is and further indicates the alarming health problems within Indigenous communities. Furthermore, Aboriginal Infant mortality rates are 3x higher than the Australian average, with 32.7% of indigenous peoples snoking, 43.8%. Living under the Federal soverty line and SO.7:1. of the community referring to a health clinic for advice and assistance, rather than a doctor. This indicates that Aboriginal people
