Houses often had shops connected attached to them, although disconnected from the house to maintain their privacy. This atrium was seen in source B. The atrium was the first room in the house and where visitors and clients were greeted, also shown in source B. The Atrium was often lavishly decorated for this reason. Source E reveals this as it states "wall, which appear as if of coloured marble"
