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Question 21 (7 marks)

- (a) What is meant by the term ecologically sustainable food production?

 The growth of crops is done without the use of fertilisers, in secticides and other chemicals that may damage the emmonment. An example is organic farming.
- Discuss the use of genetically modified crops in food production. Genetically modified crops are produced by placing a gene from another organism into a plant or animal. This may allow a larger yield, more disease-resistant crops or animals, the ability of plants / animals to withstand high or low temperatures, or food with added untients that can assist those in developing countries to consume sufficient untients, preventing malnowishment, However this poses a vish as diseases can become vesistant and develop strength, there are ethical concerns and it may conflict with religious or authoral reliefs and values.
