Question 16 (6 marks)

(a) Define the terms *anatomy* and *physiology*.

Anatomy - is the study of the body + how it works - heart, lungs (may organs). Physiology - is the study of the body and how it moves and works. - bones, muscles etc.

Provide an example of homeostasis and explain how it works.
