

Client centered care is when the client is the main priority e.g. a nurse looking after a patient. The nurse needs to make the patient well looked after such as showering & feeding the patient.

Confidentiality is when you as a nurse are not allowed to discuss patient outside of the working environment. In some cases you are not allowed to tell the family it is up to the patient to tell them if they want the family to know.

duty of care is when you have being given a duty to take care of someone. Such as a nurse be given a set group of patients to look after.

In an aged care environment client centered care is looking after the client/patient until they are well enough to

take care of themselves. Most of the time in an aged care ~~place~~ environment the patients are there because they are unable to take care of themselves. So the client centered care is to make them as comfortable as possible and keep their hygiene up so the patient can feel well again. The confidentiality in an aged care environment is that you can not tell anyone about what is happening to the patients sometimes not even family such as if the patient was about to die it is up to them as to whether they want their family to know or not. If they do want their family to know they may ask you to ~~tell them~~ let their family know or may want to tell them themselves. The duty of care is to help the patient out as much as possible eg. helping them take a shower or brush their teeth. ~~prop~~ Because of the

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age of a patient their bones may grow weak and they may be unable to perform these tasks themselves.

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
