

#### Order of construction:

#### Flow Chart:

Sewing the skirt- 1. Cut out the fabric. 2. Attach the panels around the skirt and overlock 3. Put all the fabric together, baiste these together then machine stitch. 4. Gather the fabric together and machine stitch then attach the waist band to the fabric and machine stitch.

- 5. Put the hook and eye on the waste band.
- 6.Level; skirt at the desired hem and zigzag over the hem, three times and trim. 7. Begin decorating the skirt with sequences and beads.

Sewing the Bodice- 1. Cut out the fabric. 2. Attach the panels together including facing at center back.

- 3. Baiste the boning on then machine stitch. 4. Baiste the hooks and eyes on center back and machine stitch.
- 5. Stitch facing side to front side of top and bottom edge. 6. Trim and nick edges, turn over. 7. Another stitch around facing edge to create the roll so the facing won't show. 8. Slip stitch edges center back-iron.

Sewing the Bag- 1. Cut out the fabric. 2. Sew around edge.

- 3. Trim and nick-turn over-iron. 4. Bead and sequence.
- 5.Add metal clip top- hand stitch this to the bag.

<u>Constructing the Headpiece-</u> 1. Attach a few shell together in a decorative way with wire. 2. Attach the connected shells to the thicker wire in an round shape.
