HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Allied Health Assistance (360 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 6 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all compulsory units of competency and elective units of competency to a minimum of 135 HSC indicative hours.

Allied Health Assistance Specialisation (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt elective units of competency to a minimum of 120 HSC indicative hours.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

Access including access by students in Stage 5

This course is available to students who are participating in an approved school-based traineeship training contract.
