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HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Computer Aided Drafting (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt NSWTMET00IA (Group 1) and Group 2 units of competency to a minimum of 110 HSC indicative hours
- undertake a minimum of 35 hours of mandatory work placement *

Computer Aided Drafting (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt NSWTMET00IA (Group 1) and Group 2 and/or 3 units of competency to a minimum of 230 HSC indicative hours
- undertake a minimum of 70 hours of mandatory work placement *

* It is permissible to meet this requirement through a simulated workplace. All simulated workplace training will be carried out on industry-standard computer equipment and all work produced will be to industry standards and Australian Drawing Standards.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

Under some circumstances, students' part-time work in an appropriate workplace may be used to fulfil work placement requirements. Refer to the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual* or relevant Board of Studies Official Notices for further details.
