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HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Fashion and Textiles (120 hrs)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt units of competency to a minimum of 65 HSC indicative hours including:
 - at least two units of competency from one subgroup (subgroups 1–4)
 - plus one other unit of competency from any of the subgroups.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

AQF VET credential

To attain Certificate 1 in Textile Clothing and Footwear Manufacture (LMT11106) students must achieve 6 units of competency including:

- a) 3 mandatory units of competency (Group 1)
- b) a minimum of 2 specialist units of competency (subgroups 1–4)
- c) 1 other unit of competency (subgroups).
