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### HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

#### Horticulture (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all compulsory units of competency and elective units of competency to a minimum of 180 HSC indicative hours.

To count a course towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

The pattern of study entered (for example 2 units x 2 years) should reflect the delivery of the course over successive years. Students will be credentialled for the HSC unit credit entered each calendar year provided they have satisfactorily completed the course requirements for that calendar year as determined by the school/RTO.

### Access including access by students in Stage 5

This course is available to students undertaking a school-based traineeship.

In certain circumstances students in Stage 5 may access this Stage 6 VET course while also completing the requirements for the award of the School Certificate. Certificate II in Horticulture (Wholesale Nursery) (RTF20603), or

Certificate II in Horticulture (Parks and Gardens) (RTF20703)

students must achieve 17 units of competency including:

- b) 5 additional units of competency from Groups A and/or B
- c) 3 additional units of competency from Groups A, B and/or C.
