HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Outdoor Recreation (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all Group 1 units of competency and all units of competency from one subgroup in Group 3 (Activity Specialisations) to a minimum of 60 HSC indicative hours.

Outdoor Recreation (180 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 3 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all Group 1 units of competency, Group 2 units of competency to a minimum of 60 HSC indicative hours and all units of competency from one subgroup in Group 3 (Activity Specialisations) to a minimum of 60 HSC indicative hours.

Outdoor Recreation (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all units of competency in Groups 1 and 2 and all units of competency from two subgroups in Group 3 (Activity Specialisations*) and/or Group 4 (General Specialisations).

* at least one subgroup of the Activity Specialisations must be undertaken
