HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

Recreational Fishing Industry (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt modules/units of competency to a minimum of 120 HSC indicative hours.

Recreational Fishing Industry (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all Group 1 modules/units of competency (145 HSC indicative hours) and Group 2 modules/units of competency to a total minimum of 240 HSC indicative hours.

For a course to count towards the HSC program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 8.4 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

AQF VET credential

To attain the Certificate II in Fishing Industry – Recreational Services (90886NSW), students must achieve all Group 1 modules/units of competency and Group 2 modules/units of competency to a minimum of 110 hours.
