Course requirements

This course will be credentialed as a 100-hour elective on the School Certificate.

Students must attempt:

- all compulsory units of competency
- plus one specialisation (one technical unit of competency and three elective units of competency).

Note: Students must have a 200-hour course other than English, Mathematics and Science in Stage 5 before any 100-hour course will be credentialed. Refer to Section 4.5.1 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

To count a course towards the School Certificate program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 4.3 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

Access to VET by students in Stage 5

Undertaking a VET course in Stage 5 is an option for students as part of a broad general education leading to recognised schooling and VET sector qualifications. Students must also complete the mandatory requirements of the School Certificate, including the development of essential literacy and numeracy skills.
