Course requirements

This course will be credentialed as a 100-hour elective on the School Certificate.

Students must attempt:

- all compulsory units of competency
- and elective units of competency to a minimum of 45 SC indicative hours (to obtain Certificate I in Transport and Logistics (Pathways) (TLIPC07) students must achieve 3 elective units of competency).

To count a course towards the School Certificate program of study students must satisfy the course completion criteria as required by the Board of Studies. Refer to Section 4.3 of the *Assessment, Certification and Examination (ACE) Manual*.

Access to VET by students in Stage 5

Undertaking a VET course in Stage 5 is an option for students as part of a broad general education leading to recognised schooling and VET sector qualifications. Students must also complete the mandatory requirements of the School Certificate, including the development of essential literacy and numeracy skills.
