### HSC unit credit and course requirements

HSC unit credit for VET courses can be accredited to the Preliminary and/or HSC pattern of study.

#### Beauty Therapy – Nail Technology (120 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 2 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all units of competency in Group 1.

#### Beauty Therapy (240 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 4 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all units of competency from Group 1 and Group 2A units of competency to a minimum of 100 HSC indicative hours
- undertake a minimum of 70 hours of mandatory work placement (it is permissible for this to be undertaken concurrently with the course delivery in a simulated work environment).

*For school-based trainees only:*

#### Beauty Therapy – Nail Technology (300 indicative hours)

- accredited for a total of 5 units at the Preliminary and/or HSC level
- attempt all units of competency from Group 1, at least 7 units of competency from Group 2B (as directed in the table below) and the unit of competency and 2 modules from Group 3
- mandatory work placement requirements for this course are met through the on-the-job training component of the school-based traineeship.
