Demonstrates a substantial global and detailed understanding of German by processing and responding to spoken and written texts. Communicates quite effectively through the exchange of relevant information and some ideas in spoken and written German. Demonstrates a good command of a range of vocabulary and language structures. Manipulates language structures with reasonable proficiency, although there may be lexical and syntactical errors. Links ideas and information effectively. Conveys a reasonable global and detailed understanding of spoken and written texts by identifying gist and some specific detail. Demonstrates the ability to sustain spoken and written communication at a basic level. Demonstrates a basic knowledge of vocabulary and language structures, although with reliance on English syntax and frequent grammatical errors. Links some ideas and information. Demonstrates the ability to identify the general gist and some specific details from spoken and written German. Demonstrates the ability to communicate a limited range of ideas and information, using single words or simple phrases with frequent errors. Communicates with frequent reliance on English syntax and anglicisms in spoken and written German. Demonstrates a limited knowledge of vocabulary and language structures. Demonstrates a Band 2 limited ability to identify relevant detail from spoken and written texts. A mark in this band indicates that the student has achieved below the minimum standard expected.
