QUESTION 1. Renaissance

Discuss the impact of Louis XIV on the establishment of classical ballet as a performing art.

QUESTION 2. Pre-Romantic

Explore the origin of codified classical ballet technique in the Pre-Romantic era.

QUESTION 3. Romantic

Choose EITHER La Sylphide OR Giselle and discuss the features that identify it as a 'Romantic' ballet.

QUESTION 4. British Ballet

Discuss a major dance figure of the early twentieth century who influenced the popularity of ballet in Britain.

QUESTION 5. Russian Ballet

What features of Russian ballet can be related to historical change?

QUESTION 6. Diaghilev

'Diaghilev had the ability to bring together artistes from various artistic disciplines.'

Relate this statement to ONE ballet of the Diaghilev era.

QUESTION 7. Twentieth-Century American Ballet

How has classical ballet in America been influenced by contemporary dance? Give examples in your answer.
