ῆμην ἐν θαλάμῳ, ἔθελον δ' ἄχει προτραπέσθαι.
νῦν δέ με παρειποῦσ' ἄλοχος μαλακοῖς ἐπέεσσιν
ἄρμησ' ἐς πόλεμον, δοκέει δέ μοι ὅδε καὶ αὐτῷ
λώιον ἔσσεσθαι· νίκη δ' ἐπαμείβεται ἄνδρας.

'Ηέλιος θ', ὃς πάντ' ἐφορᾶς καὶ πάντ' ἐπακούεις,
καὶ ποταμοὶ καὶ γαῖα, καὶ οἱ ὑπένερθε καμόντας
ἀνθρώπους τίνυσθον, ὅτις κ' ἐπίορκον ὄμόσσῃ,
ἥμεις μάρτυροι ἔστε, φυλάσσετε δ' ὄρκια πιστά·
εἰ μέν κεν Μενέλαιον Ἀλέξανδρος καταπέφνῃ,
αὐτὸς ἔπειθ' Ἐλένην ἔχέτω καὶ κτήματα πάντα,
ἥμεις δ' ἐν νήεσσι νεώμεθα ποντοπόροισιν·
εἰ δέ κ' Ἀλέξανδρον κτείνῃ ξανθὸς Μενέλαιος,
