SITUATION 1. Keeping Fit

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE	Say what you do to keep fit. Mention TWO thing	gs.
EXAMINER		

CANDIDATE Say that you prefer swimming to jogging. Say why.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say where you like to swim and why.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say that you usually swim every morning but on Sunday you like to sleep in.

SITUATION 2. Talking to a Friend

CANDIDATE	Reply no, you c	lon't feel like	going to the mo	ovies. Explain	why.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say that you've just had an argument with your boyfriend/girlfriend. Explain what it was about.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say that could be a good idea. Explain that you don't have any money. Ask if you could borrow 20 marks until Saturday.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Suggest a time and place to meet.

SITUATION 3. Part-time Work

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say that you've just spent almost 200 marks on new clothes. Describe what you bought.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE *Explain that you work every Saturday. You have to work all day, but you earn 50 marks.*

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Describe the work you have to do. Mention THREE things about it.

EXAMINER

CANDIDATE Say that you are often too tired to go out on a Saturday night. But on Sundays there is always a lot to do.

SITUATION 4. Studying in Germany

EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Explain why you want to go to university in Germany.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Say where you would like to study and why you like that particular town.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Explain that you were born in Australia but that your mother is German. She often speaks German at home.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Say why you are used to writing in German.

SITUATION 5. Grandparents

EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Say that you get on very well with your grandparents and say why.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Say that you visit them once a week and describe THREE things you do to help them around the house.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Say how they spend their time.
EXAMINER	
CANDIDATE	Ask if the person would like to meet them and suggest that he/she comes by on Saturday night.
