SECTION I—TRAVELLER ABROAD

Situations 1–5 are COMPULSORY.

Respond to the following in **INDONESIAN**.

You are **NOT** required to produce a dialogue or read the English cues onto the tape.

SITUATION 1. In a restaurant

- Ask if there is a table with a view of the rice fields.
- Tell the waiter that you are ready to order.
- Ask for fried chicken and vegetables for two, and some steamed rice.
- Ask if there is a performance at the restaurant tonight.

SITUATION 2. At the chemist

- Say that you have been feeling nauseous and have not eaten for two days.
- Ask the chemist to recommend a suitable medicine.
- Agree that if you do not feel better tomorrow you will see a doctor.
- Ask the location of the nearest doctor.

SITUATION 3. At a Balinese cremation

- Say that you are pleased because you have wanted to see a cremation for a long time.
- Ask the woman next to you if you are allowed to take photographs.
- Exclaim how hot the weather is today.
- Suggest to your friend that you buy a drink from the drink seller.

SITUATION 4. At the police station

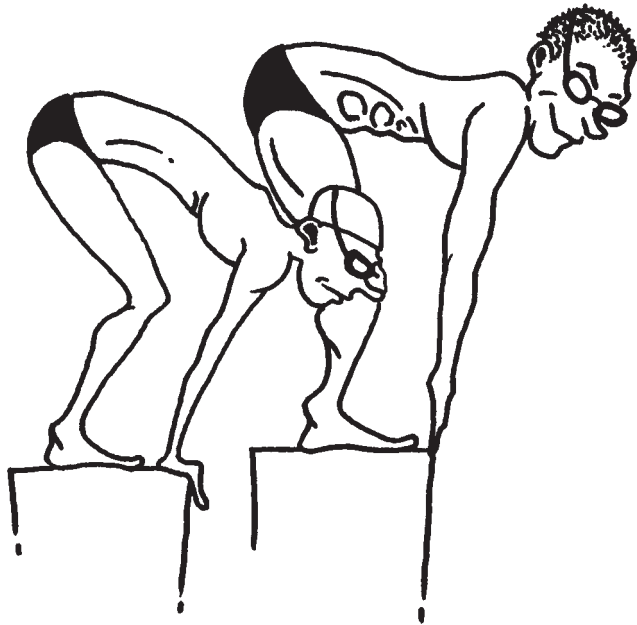
- Say that you lost your passport yesterday.
- Explain that it happened when you were shopping at the market.
- Say that you think you were pickpocketed.
- Ask what you need to do now.

SITUATION 5. Returning to your hotel after sightseeing

- Ask the woman at reception for the key to Room 433.
- Tell her that you have just seen the Borobudur temple and it was really beautiful.
- Ask her for a towel because you are going direct to the swimming pool.
- Ask if anyone has left a message for you while you were sightseeing.
