4. You are talking to an Italian friend about where you lived in Australia.
 - Say that you grew up in a suburb a few kilometres from the city centre.
 - Say that it was pleasant living there, because there were many young people of different cultures.
 - Say that unfortunately traffic pollution is worse now.
 - Say that when he/she comes to Australia you will show him/her your favourite places.
