SECTION I—SITUATIONS

(10 Marks)

- 1. You are talking to a friend.
 - Say that you have been given two tickets to a Lucio Dalla concert for next Saturday.
 - Say that it will be a great concert and ask your friend if he/she wants to come.
 - Say that the concert starts at 8 p.m. and it will be in the square in front of the cathedral.
 - Arrange a time and place to meet.
- 2. At the doctor's.
 - Greet the doctor and say that you have had terrible stomach pains all night.
 - Say that you had lunch at the fish market and that you started to feel ill in the afternoon.
 - Say that you have a temperature and you feel very weak.
 - Ask what you can take to feel better.
- 3. Ringing in response to an advertisement for a job.
 - Say that you have seen the advertisement in the paper and that you are interested.
 - Ask whether the position is still available.
 - Say that you would like to know if it is important to speak Italian fluently.
 - Say that you have experience in teaching swimming to children in Australia.
- **4.** You are in the Tourist Information Bureau in Piazza Garibaldi, Naples. You want to organise a day trip for yourself and two friends to Pompei.
 - Ask whether it is better to go by bus or train.
 - Ask for a train timetable.
 - Ask if there are guided tours once you arrive there and how much they cost.
 - Ask at what time the tours start and how long they last.
- **5.** You are at the San Lorenzo markets in Florence.
 - Ask how much that backpack over there costs.
 - Ask if they have a similar one with more pockets.
 - Say that you like it, but 90 000 lire is too much and ask for a discount.
 - Say that it is still too expensive and you will have to think about it.
