QUESTION 1 (8 marks)

Situation 1

You are working at the Hotel Information Centre at the airport. A Japanese tourist comes up to you at the counter.

Situation 2

You are a tour guide in charge of a group of Japanese tourists on a day trip to an island in Queensland.

YOU Please listen for a moment, everybody.

We will be here for six hours.

You can do lots of sports activities.

TOURIST あまりスポーツは好きじゃないですが・・・

YOU Well, how about going for a walk?

There is a little road around the island.

On the way you can see beautiful birds in the trees.

TOURIST おみやげやがありますか。

YOU Yes, there is.

It is next to the restaurant.

They sell T-shirts, hats, and so on.

TOURIST おひるごはんは？

YOU Lunch is free of charge, and is from 12.30 pm until 2 pm.
