QUESTION 1. (8 marks)

Situation 1

You are working at a hotel in Sydney. A Japanese couple wants to book a tour.

- TOURIST すみませんが、あした、ツアーに行きたいんですが. . .
- YOU How about a day trip to the Blue Mountains? The scenery is wonderful.
- TOURIST そうですね。どんな所ですか。
- YOU It is spring now.. so there are some beautiful gardens. The flowers are in bloom. At Katoomba, you can also see the famous Three Sisters. Please take your camera.
- TOURIST おひるはどうなっていますか。
- YOU A cafe lunch is included. The bus will stop at many scenic spots on the way.
- TOURIST じゃ、そのツアーにします。
- YOU Please board the bus at the front of the hotel at 8.30 am. Please DO NOT be late.

Situation 2

You are accompanying the bus tour to the Blue Mountains. An anxious passenger approaches you.

- YOU What has happened?
- TOURIST すみませんが、ハンドバッグが見つかりません。
- YOU Where do you think you lost it?
- TOURIST わかりません。
- YOU Were your passport and traveller's cheques inside?
- TOURIST ええ。
- YOU If you have the cheque numbers, please give them to me.
- TOURIST はい、これです。
- YOU Don't worry. I will contact the bank immediately. You can get new ones today. I will also telephone the Japanese consulate. Now, I will take you to the police. It would be better to tell them.
- TOURIST どうも。よろしくおねがいします。

QUESTION 2. (7 marks)

You are a tourist guide speaking to a group of Japanese tourists. Choose **TWO** of the following topics and speak for approximately **ONE** minute, but no more than $1\frac{1}{2}$ minutes on each.

Please state (a), (b) or (c) before you begin speaking.

- (a) Talk about **TWO** places of interest outside NSW.
- (b) Talk about your local area.
- (c) Talk about **ONE** Australian animal **AND** **ONE** native plant.
