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QUESTION 1. Families and the Law

EITHER

- (a) Workplace laws and regulations reflect a valuing of family life.

Evaluate this statement in relation to THREE of the following:

- maternity and paternity leave
- compulsory superannuation schemes
- occupational health and safety
- equal employment opportunity
- affirmative action.

OR

- (b) (i) Identify ONE piece of legislation related to child support or child protection.
- (ii) Describe the purpose of the legislation, and how it is monitored.
- (iii) Critically discuss issues associated with the effectiveness of this legislation.

QUESTION 2. Leadership and Group Dynamics

EITHER

- (a) Leadership is a significant determinant of group effectiveness.

Justify this statement.

OR

- (b) (i) How may conflict serve as a constructive force as well as a destructive force in organizations?
- (ii) Assess the potential of THREE specific management strategies to minimize destructive aspects of conflict.

QUESTION 3. Management Strategies for Specific Needs*EITHER*

- (a) You have been asked to do a needs assessment for ONE of the following groups in your local community:
- rural families in crisis
 - people with disabilities
 - homeless youth.
- (i) Outline a research plan to identify the group's needs.
- (ii) Justify your choice of research strategies for this particular group.

OR

- (b) Select ONE specific group you have studied.

Evaluate how current societal structures affect the ability of individuals in this group to satisfy their needs.

QUESTION 4. Socialization of Children*EITHER*

- (a) (i) Analyse the role of play in the socialization process.
- (ii) Examine how socio-economic and cultural factors influence the nature of play opportunities.

OR

- (b) Critically analyse the factors that contribute to gender-role stereotyping.

- (a) Explain, using examples, how changes in the labour market are related to THREE of the following community issues.

 - welfare
