DIRECTIONS TO TEACHER/EXAMINER AND CANDIDATES

QUESTION 1

Tell your waiter/waitress what Thai food you like, and that you can't eat food that is too spicy. Remember to order something to drink and some Thai fruit to have after your meal.

QUESTION 2

You (the candidate) are shopping in the street near your hotel in Bangkok.

You are interested in buying a shirt (or two).

You must specify the quantity, colour and size of the shirt(s) you wish to buy. You must also bargain with the vendor (the examiner) for the best price.

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
