THE GOVERNMENT HAS PROVIDED HEALTH FACILITIES (WAMS - WALGETI) AND SIMILAR FACILITIES THROUGHOUT AUSTRALIA TO PROVIDE FOR THE HEALTH NEEDS OF ALL INDIGENOUS COMMUNITIES. THEY INCLUDE VISITING SPECIALISTS, DOCTORS, DENTISTS, TRANSPORT TO MAJOR CENTRES, COMMUNITY HEALTH CENTRES, NURSES, IMMUNISATION PROGRAMS & HEALTH/SEX EDUCATION THROUGH SCHOOLS.

HOUSING PROVISION TO MOST COMMUNITIES.
