

Start here. The student should use ethical ~~research~~ research practices ~~because~~ because ~~the~~ the Aboriginal community may not want to ~~work~~ answer ~~of~~ the students questions. Respecting Indigenous knowledge will show the Indigenous ~~person~~ person that the student isn't disrespectful ~~and~~ of the Indigenous culture and of ~~his~~ their knowledge. Acknowledging intellectual property and ~~copy~~ copyright shows the student is getting his information from a source and ~~the~~ ~~Aboriginal~~ acknowledges the Aboriginal person respectfully. Consultation protocols are giving the person you are studying a set of questions you will ask them before the consultation has taken place. Also ask respectfully if you can ~~do~~ ~~research~~ research them and provide your reasons for study and what you are studying. Consultation protocols provide the Aboriginal person with the correct information so they can decide if they want to ~~be~~ be asked the ~~questions~~ questions or be a part of the study.

It also shows the student wants to consult the person respectfully and only with their permission.

These ethical ~~ness~~ research practices are in place so nobody is disrespected or ~~bad~~ treated wrongly ~~with~~ while they are being studied. So the student should use them, so they don't offend anyone in the making of their research.
