

- 4 What do Sources B and C reveal about the uses of houses in Pompeii? 3

Sources B and C reveal the different types of houses used in Pompeii. The atrium houses were basic houses where the average lived. The main room (e.g. the ^{host} ^{host}) was the living room. The next type of house is Atrium Peristyle houses which were slightly more luxurious with a veranda. The House of Faun is an example of this house. At the next stage of housing were Villas. They were surrounded by luxurious gardens & fountains. The rich lived in these houses. An example includes the Villa of the Popuri discovered by Carl Weber.
