Businesses within the automotive industry are addressing the challenges ~~of~~ of significantly changing technology, materials, repair techniques and sustainable practice by highlighting the cost of training workers and changing workshop procedures as well as the cost to set up & needed equipment in order to keep in the automotive repair industry.

Repair techniques alter between different businesses and tradespersons. By having new techniques of repairing vehicles the trades person is likely to have to take a longer time working on the vehicle due to not being able to follow their own way of fixing the vehicle. New tools being invested highlights the direct cost of the mechanic as they will have to purchase these tools as their existing tools may not provide the operations to complete the task. Vehicles becoming more technologically advanced also highlight the need for new diagnosis tools eg computer code readers.

Workers will be expected to apply their skills to learn how to work on different materials eg ~~the~~ all aluminium engine blocks opposed to cast iron. This change will see workers having to develop their skills to work with a broader range of materials. Initially the process will be a hindrance on businesses as they will have to train staff members on new materials, ~~the~~ how to work on and repair different materials as well as the different safety procedures associated with them. Materials may also place businesses under financial hardship due to some materials costing significantly more to produce.

Ensuring sustainable practice is another challenge businesses are addressing as they will need to spend money on the adequate training of staff to ensure they are able to maintain safe working processes such as following PPE requirements signs eg wear safety glasses.

Some businesses may not have the required ~~the~~ trained personnel highlighting their loss of business due to not being able to take on work as they can't comply with necessary qualifications to participate in automotive repair work.
