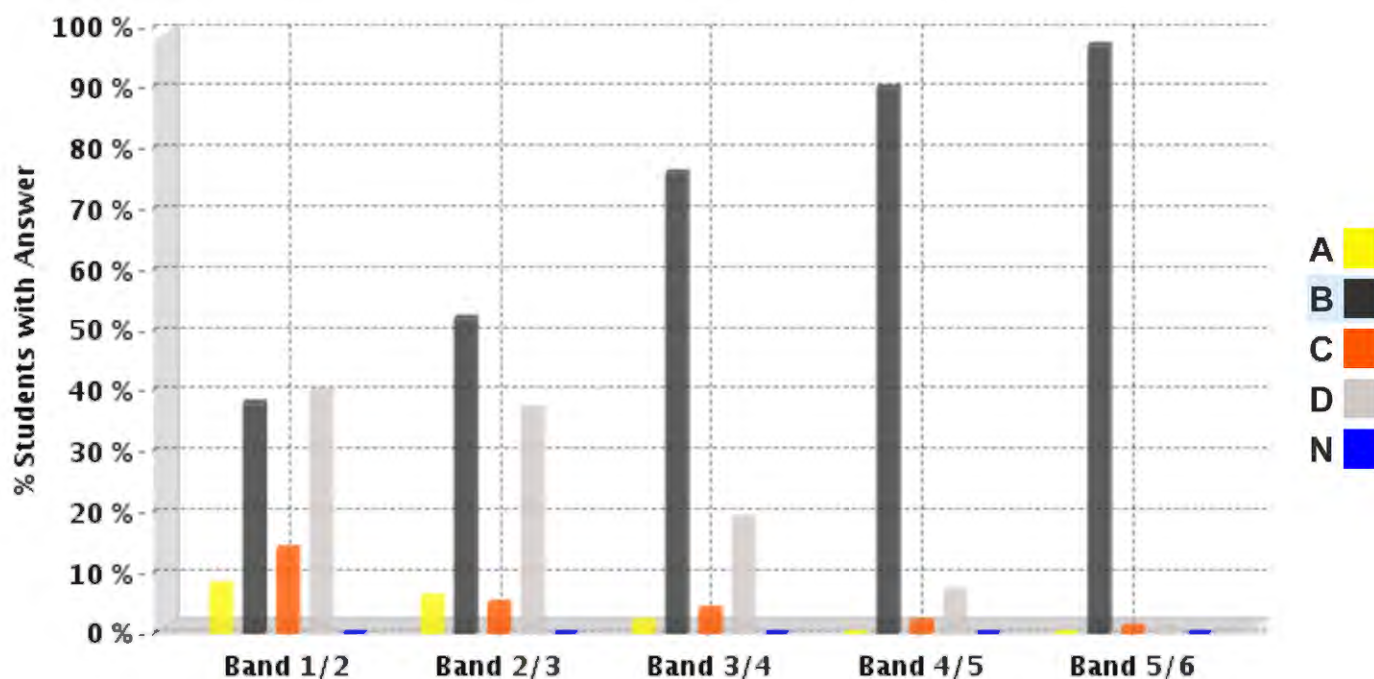
Information about four companies is shown in the table.
