Transitioning is a process where someone travels physically or mentally through a phase, where at the other side ~~that things~~ ^{new concepts} can change like ~~attitudes or beliefs~~ challenge ~~a~~ previously held ~~attitudes~~ attitudes, ~~or~~ beliefs or both. The texts "The story of Tom Brennan" written by J.C. Burke and the short documentary "My little town" developed and produced by Australian Story use transitions with the stories to ~~progress the story~~ to show to the audience the past attitudes and beliefs and then to demonstrate the outcomes of transitions on ~~attitudes~~ attitudes and beliefs.

"The Story of Tom Brennan" follows the changes that Tom goes through when everything he knew was gone, ~~and he had~~ ~~more~~ ~~to a different~~ By having his brother, Daniel, drink driving resulting in two deaths and causing his cousin Fin to become a paraplegic. This catalyst caused the beginning of Tom's transition,

This transition from Billi to Coghill ended up challenging his ^{previously} ~~previously~~ held attitudes and beliefs. This occurs through many events during his time in Coghill, however it comes to an end when he "finally comes back forever", at the end of the story when he decides to truly ~~be~~ on what his new ideals are.

In "My little town", Drink drive again is the catalyst for ~~the~~ ~~trans~~ transitions in this short documentary. However it takes a different turn than in "Tom Breannen", this text forces ~~the~~ the transition ending of the transition, as a member of the other family eventually took "justice" into his hands, he attempted to murder all of the family members that were related to the person who killed his son. This action ~~forced~~ forced the affected family to quickly conclude their transition and ultimately create their own attitudes and their own beliefs.

Additional writing space on back page.

Both texts use transitions to show the audience how they can affect individuals and others, how they can change or challenge attitudes and beliefs. However ~~they~~ tho they ~~are~~ are similar stories, both relating to death and drink drinking; they possess different ideals, ~~attitudes~~ attitudes and beliefs to each other. This ultimately cause each story to be different, and to display different ways those attitudes, beliefs and ideals can turn out.

Both "Tom Breannon" and "My little town", give the audience an understanding of how what and how transitions work. These text demonstrate to the audience the transition process and what can occur to previously held ideals, ~~attitudes~~ attitudes and beliefs.
