

Question 17 (8 marks)

Your neighbour has fallen from a ladder while cleaning a high window.

- (a) Describe the first aid management of this situation. 3

Put pressure on any part that is bleeding. lay them flat, call the ambulance asap, remove all danger hazards from your neighbour that could potentially harm them. Protect their head as well as their spinal cord if injured.

- (b) (i) Your neighbour has a lower leg wound that is bleeding profusely. 3

What actions should you take?

Put pressure on the wound. Call the ambulance. Elevate the injured leg. Apply direct pressure to wound to try stop the blood flow. Once it has stopped remove all soiled dressings and apply a clean wound dressing with a firm bandage over the top enough for neighbour to walk without pressure.

- (ii) Your neighbour stops breathing and is unconscious. 2

Describe how to apply CPR. DRABCD

Remove all danger hazards, Try to get a response, Check their airways, Check for breathing, Start 30 compressions and 2 breaths untill ambulance have arrived with defibrillator.
