Launching Beta versions of the website can help with bug issues as developers or keen users trial the Beta version. Uploading the website to online tools such as W3C validators can ~~allow~~ help establish code, line and image errors. Browser compatibility plays a major role for testing, by simply running the new site on several different browsers such as Chrome, Safari, IE, Opera can define issues with code that doesn't work with particular browsers. Using different OS (operating systems) to test the website can also be helpful in understanding how it functions for different users and to spot any flaws it may have on different OS.

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Sometimes even just navigating around the website and ~~rely~~ paying close attention to details such as the way images load or games function are appropriate tests in order to ~~have~~ have the most optimal functionality for your website.
