

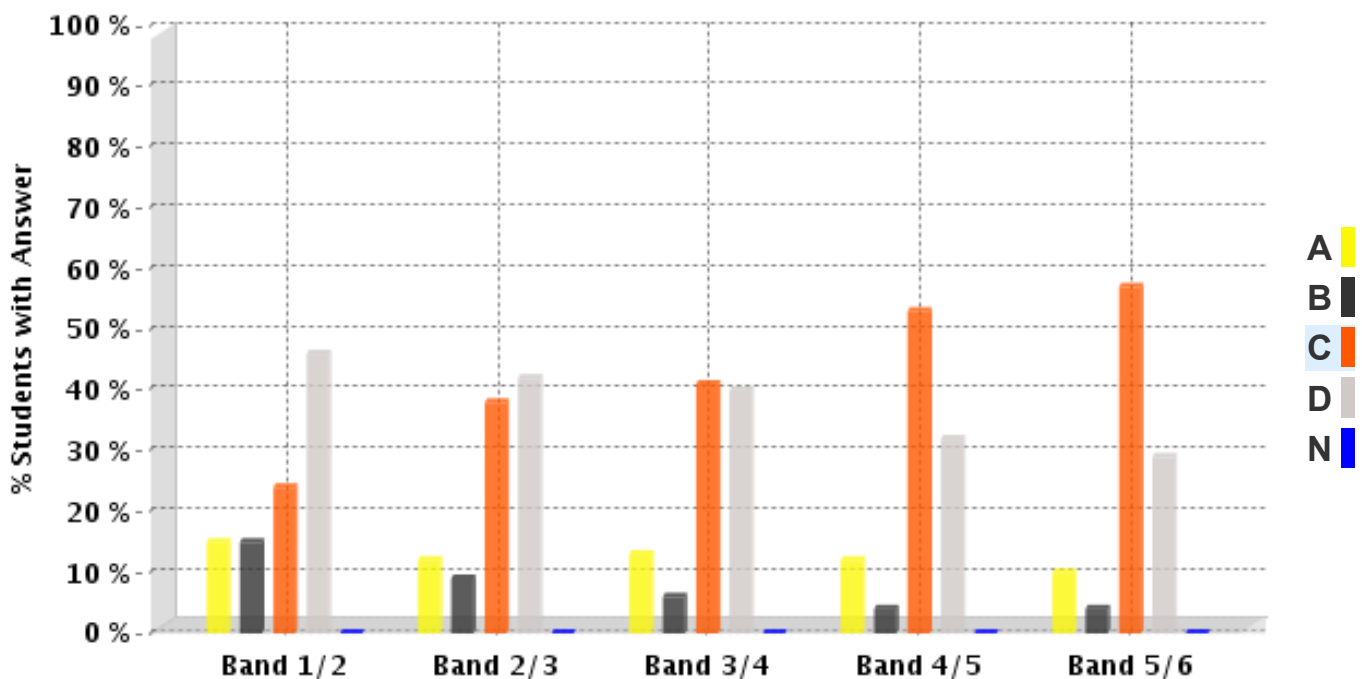
Question 8
