

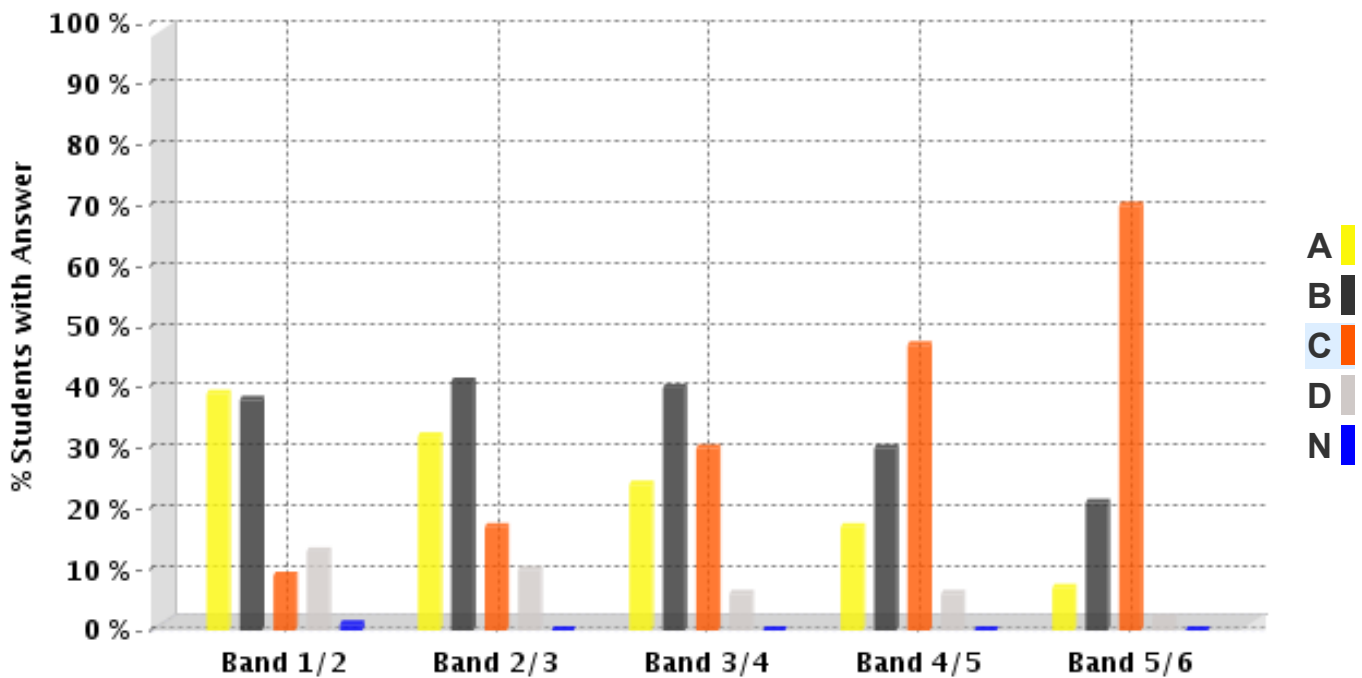
## Question 18
