




Both legal and non-legal measures have encouraged cooperations between nation states to achieve world order.

The United Nations is a legal measure that has helped to achieve and sustain world order. The United Nations has helped with world order all over the world by sending in peacekeepers and setting up humanitarian programs. The United Nations have helped countries like, East Timor, South Sudan, Korea and Ivory coast to help keep the peace and to achieve world order.

The International Criminal Court helps to achieve world order, as it deals with transnational ~~crimes~~ crimes. If two countries <sup>are</sup> having a dispute it can be taken to the International Criminal court to be resolved, instead of the two countries going to war. For example East Timor took the Australia government to the ~~leg~~ International Criminal Court over the resources in the Timor gap. This measure helps conflicts to be resolved without using violence, thus maintaining world order.

A non-legal measure that helps to maintain world order is Amnesty International. Amnesty International is a non-government

organisation that helps to protect human rights. If a country is fighting with another over human rights, Amnesty International might step in to help resolve the conflict. This organisation has helped to ~~to~~ maintain world order and help resolve conflict.

Another legal measure that is used to ~~to~~ achieve world order is peace treaties. The two opposing countries will draw up a peace treaty and it will be signed by both countries. This measure helps ~~to~~ achieve world order as it calls a truce between countries and helps to stop conflict.

The Geneva Conventions are another measure that helps with achieving world order. The Geneva Conventions were drawn up after World War II and signed by many countries. These conventions were drawn up to stop the atrocities that happened in World War II from ever happening again. These conventions help to maintain world order as they stop countries from committing really violent acts towards each other.
