Through different acts and cases you can determine how the law helps in achieving justice for parties that are involved in relationship breakdown.

Divorce is what individuals do if their marriage is broken down. For a marriage to be declared void there must be certain outcomes. These include ^{bigamy} being married to more than one person at the one time, duress, that the person must be of marriage age, which is eighteen years or over, ~~over~~ that there is a certified marriage consultant and five years separation.

Through the case *Divelli vs Montev*, duress can be seen. Also through the Matrimonial Act you can see how divorce can impact and individual.

Bigamy is when you are

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married and you have cheated on your partner. Divorces go through courts so they can reveal if the relationship is a breakdown.

Through the different acts and cases you can see how the breakdown of relationships is an ongoing process. If children are involved it makes the process a lot more complicated. This could lead to fights of who gets custody. The children's fairness act 1994 reveals that ~~the~~ whichever ever parent is more emotionally stable and also financially will have a larger impact on who receives the children.
