Start here. There is tension between community interests and individual rights and freedoms within the criminal justice system because of the way that society Views these crimes and the way the law protects the those who committed, or possibly committed those crimes. These protections are made clear by natural justice, the rule of law, the presumption of innocence and the barden of proof.

The Dea of reburd justice can also be thought of as the rie of fair play which means everybody has the right to have their case heard by an impossion of arbiter. society on the other traw hand often believes it to be in the best interests of the community if the accessed is just thrown in good without a hearing. This resultes in tention between community interest and individual rights and freedoms. The rule of law is that everyone is bound and probetted by the law equally. Society often would those who commit seriouse crimes penished More severy and condemn the justice system when individuals who society believe committed a major crine get aguithed. This results in tentions between commenty inducest and individual rights

The presemption of innocence is often stated as everyone is innocent until proven guilty. This allows for a fair trial. The media often success society into believing in someone gest before hearing the other side of the story. In only a few occasions the media will altempt to sway public opinion to innovent. This results in tentions between commenty interest and individual right and freedys. The burdon of proof is the challenge the procedition faces in proving seneones guilt. In the criminal justice system it is beyond reasonable doubt ! Society on the other hand often believe someone to be alteady guilty, usually because of the meria going against the presomption of innocence and often call for the accussed individual to heavily punished. This results in fentions between individual rights and freedoms.

The tentions between commonity interest and individual rights and freedoms within the criminal justice system are there because of societies quest for justice without just reasoning and the removal of natural justic, the role of law, the presumption of innocence and the need to prove someones guilt with the burdon of proof.
